A collection of Chinese porcelain, 18th century and later, including a blue and white export ware oval dish, Qianlong period, painted with a fenced garden, length 32cm, a blue and white ginger jar, mark of Kangxi but late 19th century, painted with p

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Oval Dish - broken into two and rivet repaired, otherwise ok.

Ginger jar with Kangxi mark - good condition, with only tiny chip to rim.

Canton vase - generally in good condition, wear to gilt and a few minor scuffs to high points.

Blue and white ginger jar and cover - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Blue and white ginger jar - 2 hairline cracks to rim, each approx 3cm long.

Pair of blue and white baluster vases - one In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, the other with repair and hairline crack to rim. Both covers badly chipped.

Similar blue and white baluster vase - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Cover badly chipped.

Famille Rose cylindrical box and cover - cover broken and re-glued, otherwise ok.

Two teacups - good condition.

Blue and white saucer - good condition.

Export famille rose saucer - cracked.

Saucer dish - discoloured and worn, otherwise ok.

Small famille rose bowl - broken in half and re-glued.
