A Chinese enameled Yixing stoneware jar and cover, late Qing dynasty, the compressed circular body painted with four floral panels, reserved against a turquoise ground, the cover with blue enameled character roundel, impressed seal mark to base, he

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Jar and Cover - generally in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Some surface wear and crazing to enamels.

Teapot - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Would probably have had a brown wash finish which is now largely worn away with patches remaining.

Vase - small chip to rim, polished/varnished and this is quite patchy.
