A Japanese Satsuma earthenware dish by Gokasai Katsujoshi, Meiji period, of scallop shell moulded form, painted and gilt with a procession of rakan crossing a bridge, above a moulded leaf rim filled with insects and a frog, lengthy gilt and iron red

Condition Report

1003. In good condition overall with no chips or restoration. There are two indistinct firing cracks visible only really to the underside along the ribs of the scallop moulding - the dense decoration to the surface hides them incredibly well - they both run from the rim edge to the footrim. Otherwise typical fine crazing to the glaze. The enamels and gilding remain strong with very minimal wear.
