### Condition Report

1010. One plate has an approx 7cm long faint hairline to the rim between 11 and 12 o'clock, otherwise both plates are in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. The enamels and gilding on both plates remain strong and bright with minimal typical wear.
