A Chinese famille rose tobacco leaf pattern export porcelain tea caddy, Qianlong period, decorated with overlapping leaves and flowers, height 10.5cm (lacking neck and chips to edges), fitted with a later silver cover.

### Condition Report

1018. The caddy is completely missing its neck, the remaining hole to the shoulders is chipped to its circumference. The rim edges of the shoulders of the caddy are fritted overall, with similar fritting to the side edges. Two base corners of the caddy are chipped. The decoration overall remains bright and strong, the gilding is worn. The cover has been replaced with a hallmarked silver inkwell cover fitted with a paintbrush.
