A Chinese blue and white porcelain ginger jar and cover, Kangxi period, painted with panels of precious objects against a prunus and cracked ice ground, underglaze blue double ring to base, height 23.7cm (minor hairline to rim).

Estimate: £500 - £800

Condition Report

1020. The cover is likely to be matched, it is of a slightly different shade of blue with a differing style of cracked ice ground. It is in good condition.

The jar has an approx 5cm long vertical hairline to the neck rim, three minor starcracks are visible to the interior walls of the jar but not visible to the exterior. The exterior glaze has overall light surface scratches commensurate with age. There is a minor (and typical) manufacturer's blemish to the footrim.
