A Japanese lacquer stand, Meiji period, of lobed oblong form, the apron decorated with gilt waves on a black ground, length 24.6cm, together with a mixed group of approximately eighteen mostly Chinese carved and pierced wood stands.

Condition Report

1021. Japanese lacquer stand - some loss to lacquer on legs and apron, also some minor chips to apron, typical wear and scratches.

Large hardwood stand - has been re-glued at joints and looks like the pierced and carved panel is a later addition.

The other stands in fair condition generally with typical chips, cracks and wear.
