A small group of Japanese pottery and porcelain, late 19th and 20th century, including an Imari charger, diameter 28.5cm, a similar plate, diameter 21.4cm, a plate printed in underglaze blue with a bird of prey, diameter 18.5cm, a two-handled vase, h

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1029. Imari dish - 1cm square chip to rim with associated 5cm hairline crack, another 2 hairlines approx 5cm and 3cm long, also typical light wear and surface scratches to gilding and enamels.

Imari plate - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Typical wear and scratches.

Blue and white dish - minor chips to rim and scratches to glaze.

Blue and white vase - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Satsuma style bowls - small bowl is chipped, both with wear to gilt and enamels.

Satsuma style vase - generally in good order with wear to gilt and enamels, lower part of vase has reddish pink stain to glaze.

5 pieces of Kutani tea ware - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Glass saucer - 2 by 6cm broken section re-glued.
