A Chinese famille rose export porcelain circular dish, Yongzheng/Qianlong period, painted with a fenced peony garden, the rim with a turquoise trellis band reserved with four floral panels, diameter 39cm (faint hairline).

Condition Report

1031. Approx 9.5cm long haircrack to rim at 9 o'clock with associated minuscule nick to enamelled pink flower on rim, there is also an approx 11cm long haircrack running between the two largest pink peony flowers - both of these are quite indistinct and only noticeable on close inspection. There is typical wear to the gilding but the enamels remain strong and bright. There are surface scratches/wear primarily visible to the largest pink peony. There are some minor manufacturer glaze blemishes, a manufacturing issue, e.g., tiny flaw to rim edge and 'dripping' to the glaze on the underside.
