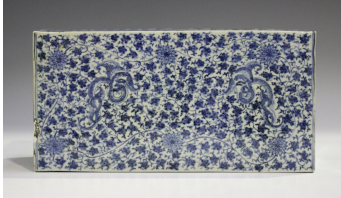

A Chinese blue and white porcelain pillow, late Qing dynasty, of rectangular form, painted to the four sides with chilong amidst peony flowers and scrolling leafy tendrils, one end pierced with a double cash motif, the other open, unmarked, length 28

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1035. There are some minor surface scratches/glaze blemishes to the body overall, nothing untoward. The aperture end has an 8cm long section of the footrim which has been broken away and restored back with some noticeable filling along the break lines and to the surface. This includes a small area of glaze loss to the bottom edge of the face above this area of footrim. There is also an approx 0.8cm square flat chip to the glaze on one of the side base corners.
