Condition Report

1038. Vase - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is some incredibly indistinct fritting and a minor unglazed spot on the otherwise glazed edge of the footrim.

Bowl - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There are a few minor manufacturer's glaze spots to the base interior.
