A Japanese silver wire inlaid cloisonné vase, Meiji period, of shouldered square tapering form, finely worked with a sparrow flying above chrysanthemums and rocks on a midnight blue ground, unsigned, height 18.3cm.

Condition Report

1047. There has obviously been some kind of impact to the left side of the vase which has caused a lot of vertical haircracks to this side, the left side edge and a number radiating across the front decoration - please see the close up images on our website using the zoom function. There are no losses or dents to the enamel. Otherwise the vase is in good condition with some minor and light surface scratches.
