Condition Report

1052. Approx 1.3cm long by 0.5cm wide chip to underside rim edge at bottom left corner and similar much smaller to bottom right corner with even smaller along top rim edge. Otherwise no restoration or cracks but typical surface wear and scratches commensurate with age and use. Gilding worn.
