A Chinese sang-de-boeuf glazed porcelain vase, late Qing dynasty, the baluster body with everted rim, unmarked, height 38.5cm (drilled hole near base).

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

1056. The vase has been drilled at some stage to the body above the footrim obviously to accommodate an electrical cable. There is a 2.5 by 0.5cm area of glaze loss to the exterior edge of the foot beneath the drilled hole and some other minor chipping/glaze loss to the edge of the foot. There is fine crazing to the glaze overall. No restoration.
