### Condition Report

1073. Fukagawa vase - in good condition with no significant damage or repairs, typical light wear to gilding and surface scratches.

Buddha - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Blue and white ginger jar - drilled hole near base where converted for table lamp, otherwise in generally good condition.

Teapot - small chip and small hairline to spout, otherwise ok.

Sancai horse - generally in good condition, no significant damage or repair.

Imari bowl - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, minor wear to gilt and enamels.
