A Chinese blue and white porcelain bottle vase, mark of Kangxi but late 19th century, the bulbous body painted with precious objects between lappet and ruyi head borders, the waisted narrow neck with stiff leaf, ruyi head and wave borders, underglaze

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

1080. In good condition overall with no restoration. Two flat chips to the neck rim exterior, 6 by 2mm and 8 by 4mm, the larger has an approx 1.5cm long vertical haircrack running from it. There are areas of wear (perhaps intentional) to some of the relief ribbing between the bands of decoration on the shoulders and widest part of the body. Overall there are surface scratches to the glaze and a number of manufacturer's blemishes to the glaze.
