A Chinese hardwood circular stand, late 19th/early 20th century, carved with a keyfret and foliate border above a carved and pierced floral panelled apron, diameter 15cm, together with a group of twelve assorted stands, a stopper/cover with carved sh

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

1084. Key fret border stand - good condition, no significant damage or repairs, minor split to frieze and a few minor scuffs.

18.8cm diameter polished hardwood stand - good condition, minor chip to rim and typical minor scuffs and scratches.

Carved and pierced stand 18cm diameter - minor shrinkage split to top, typical wear and ruyi head foot repaired.

15cm diameter stand - repair to one ruyi head foot, typical wear and scuffs.

Pair of later red stained stands 11.5cm diameter - good condition with some wear.

Pair of Japanese stands 10.5cm diameter - one with chip to base, one with chips to edges and repaired section.

Four other 20th century stands - in generally good order with minor chips.

Dish stand - good condition, polish worn.

Stopper/cover - good condition.

Two pierced domed covers - in good condition if a bit dirty and dusty.

Pierced lotus panel cover - split across top and minor chips.
