Condition Report

1096. Approx 7cm long by 1.5cm wide section of neck rim broken away in 2 pieces and visibly glued, with minor losses along the break lines. There is also an approx 1cm square chip to the rim edge with an associated short haircrack and an approx 3cm long vertical haircrack alongside it. Otherwise in good condition overall. The gilding is typically rubbed, the enamels remain bright.
