### LOT 1101

A Chinese Guan-type crackle glazed stoneware vase, the ovoid body covered in a celadon glaze suffused with a network of grey crackles, height 11.4cm, together with a similar crackle glazed bowl, diameter 14.3cm.

### Condition Report

1101. Vase - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is an approx 0.8 by 0.3cm glazed over manufacturer's chip to the edge of the footrim, and some minor blemishes to the glaze - again a manufacturing issue.

Bowl - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There are a couple of manufacturing issues to the bowl, e.g., an uneven distribution of glaze and a minor firing crack and chip to the footrim.
