A Chinese carved celadon jade ruyi sceptre, late Qing dynasty or later, the serpentine handle carved in relief with lingzhi fungus, length 36.5cm.

Estimate: £4,000 - £6,000

Condition Report

1115. There is a repair to the top end of the handle behind the head and another repair approx 6cm below this just as the carved decoration begins - both of these appear to be clean breaks which have been professionally repaired, possibly including some re-carving to the foliage behind the head of the ruyi. The rest of the handle is in good condition with good carving and a uniform colour to the stone.
