Condition Report

1117. Plate One - approx 11cm long branched haircrack to centre, 2 small chips and some minor frits/nicks to rim edge. Some stacking wear, gilding rubbed.

Plate Two - approx 4cm long branched haircrack to rim at 10 o'clock. Typical light wear.

Plate Three - one small chips and a number of minor frits to rim, some stacking wear.

Plate Four - broken into at least 4 pieces and visibly completely very poorly restored.
