### Condition Report

1133. Largest rectangular teapot - generally in good condition, tiny chips to two bottom corners - nothing significant - otherwise no cracks or repairs. Minor chip to one corner of cover. The teapot has been covered in what looks like some sort of clear varnish, as you can see from our online images this has significantly worn away in places and does appear to be easily cleaned off.

Cylindrical teapot - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Compressed circular teapot - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
