1145. Generally in good condition with no significant damage or repairs, a couple of minor scuffs/chips to leaves of banana plant. Please note there is a hairline inclusion to the shoulder/body of the vase to the left of the banana plant, and there is a brown hairline inclusion running through the banana plant - not obviously visible as it is incorporated within the carving.
