Condition Report

323. Engine turned box - numerous small dents to sides and top, typical light wear. Dent to front right bottom corner. Hinge is good and closes tightly.

London 1919 box - numerous dents all over box, split to front left and right corners of lid. Lid does not close fully and gapes. Engraved inscription.

Birmingham 1938 box - numerous dents all over, tired and bit worn. Hinge is good and closes tightly.
