A George V silver sugar caster of octagonal baluster form, Sheffield 1921 by Walker & Hall, height 16cm, together with a small group of other silver items, including an Art Nouveau shaped rectangular dressing table tray, decorated with stylized scrolling tendrils, Sheffield 1909 by Walker & Hall, length 20.4cm, total weight 284g, and a silver square compact with applied initials, London 1938 by Asprey & Co Ltd.

Condition Report

348. Caster – numerous dents and misshapen foot.

Art Nouveau tray – generally good order with typical wear and surface scratches. Good clear hallmark. Engraved 'M' initial.

Compact – good condition, engraved inscription.

Pierced dish – par of handle missing and no glass liner.

Embossed bonbon dish – worn with tears/splits to rim.

Napkin ring – slight misshaping, otherwise ok. No engraving. Good clear marks.
