A pair of late Victorian silver pepper casters, each of spiral reeded ogee baluster form with pierced dome screw cover and circular foot, London 1888 (maker's mark rubbed), height 12cm, together with a silver cream jug, a silver mustard and a silver spoon, total weight 275.7g.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

358. Pepper casters – both with minor dents and typical wear. Both bases/stems slightly misshapen so do not sit quite straight. Both screw threads to cover in good working order. Marks a bit rubbed.

Cream jug – good condition, typical minor surface scratches and wear.

Mustard – good condition, typical light surface wear.
