An early 20th century Russian Fabergé silver figure group, circa 1908-1926, 84 zolotnik, finely modelled as a huntsman on horseback looking down at five seated hounds, on an ivory base with malachite bun feet, Fabergé initials mark to all pieces and St Petersburg Kokoshnik mark to leg of horse, total height 12.2cm (minor faults).

Condition Report

400. The silver figures are in generally very good condition. Typical light surface scratches and wear visible under magnification, but no significant damage or repairs. Very crisp decoration and detail. Only damage of any note is a section of rein missing from his left hand. Good clear mark to horse's leg and hounds tails. The horse is missing its securing nuts to underside of base so sits in place but is essentially loose. All hounds in good condition and securely fitted. Ivory base in good order and malachite feet in good condition.
