A pair of Moorcroft Eventide pattern candlesticks, circa 1925, each of cylindrical form, impressed marks and painted William Moorcroft signature to bases, height 20.8cm (one with restoration to rim of sconce).

Estimate: £600 - £1,000

Condition Report

1402. Both with typical overall fine crazing to the glaze. The pair are a good colour match.

First - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Second - There is an area of professional restoration to the sconce approx 8cm long (half the circumference of the sconce) and approx 2cm long at its deepest point (encompassing the curved side of the sconce and sitting just at the top of the vertical stem). This restoration is incredibly well executed and only really noticeable by the absence of crazing in this area. The rest of the candlestick is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
