A pair of Macintyre & Co Aurelian pottery vases, late 19th century, designed by Moorcroft, the gently waisted bodies decorated in gilt enriched Japan colours with a poppy pattern, brown printed factory marks to bases with 'Rd No 314901' and painted 'M428', height 16cm (minor restoration to one rim).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1510. First - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Black pitting to underside where marks are. Two minor pinhead sized glaze blemishes to surface approx 3cm above footrim. Gilding in good condition with some very minor wear and light surface scratches.

Second - Approx 5cm long section of professional restoration to upper rim edge, reaching approx 1cm down into body of vase to where first horizontal gilt band is. Otherwise in good condition overall with light surface scratches/wear.
