A good Martin Brothers stoneware bird vase, dated May 1894, the tapered ovoid body incised and painted with caricatures of herons amongst bulrushes and grasses, the gently flared cylindrical neck decorated with insects, incised marks to base, height 23.5cm.

Estimate: £1,500 - £2,000

Condition Report

1554. In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

There are a few very minor burst air bubbles to the glaze surface, e.g., to the head of one bird, and a small convex blemish to the body over one of the grass stems, approx 4cm from the footrim - both of these are manufacturing issues and should not be considered as damage.
