## **LOT 1555**

A pair of Martin Brothers stoneware vases, dated February 1892, the high-shouldered bodies incised and painted with insects amidst white lily flowers, the gently flared cylindrical necks decorated with insects, incised marks to bases, height 24cm.

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

## **Condition Report**

1555. Both vases are in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

One has an approx 3.5cm long firing crack to the base underside through the incised mark - please see the extra images on our website using the zoom function. The other vase has some minor fritting to the top rim edge of the neck, a manufacturing issue.
