A late Victorian Scottish silver three-piece tea set, comprising teapot, two-handled sugar bowl and milk jug, each ovoid body embossed with oval panels of Renaissance figures within elaborate framing, Glasgow 1893 by James Reid & Co, total weight 1145.3g, height of teapot 22.5cm.

Condition Report

435. Teapot - generally good condition, slight misshaping to foot. Typical light surface scratches and wear and few very minor dents to body.

Jug - good condition, no significant damage or repairs, typical light surface scratches and wear. Couple of very minor dents to body.

Sugar bowl - generally good condition, slight misshaping to foot. Typical minor surface scratches and wear and a few minor dents to body.

All with good clear matching hallmarks.
