A set of four Victorian silver candlesticks, each with detachable nozzle above a turned urn-shaped sconce and foliate knopped stem, on a shaped square base with foliate corner crests, London 1845 by Creswick & Co, height 23.4cm.

Condition Report

440. The set of four candlesticks in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. One has a dented sconce. Others with only minor nicks and dents and typical light surface scratches and wear. All marks to sticks and nozzles are matching. No engraved initials, crests and no erasures. Total weight 2280g, but they are filled/weighted with an unusual silver covered underside/base. They are not cast candlesticks.
