A George II silver trophy cup and cover with turned finial, the 'U' shaped body engraved with a coat of arms above a central reeded girdle, flanked by a pair of foliate capped scroll handles, on a stepped circular foot, London 1749 by Fuller White, weight 1778.5g, height 31.5cm.

Condition Report

455. The cup is in good condition with no apparent damage or repairs. Tiny dent to underside of body but of no real significance. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Handles in good order. Good crisply engraved armorial. Good clear hallmarks to underside of foot.

Cover in generally good order with matching hallmarks. Few minor dents and small tear/split (1.4cm long) around edge of rim and typical minor misshaping to rim (visible in shot 5 on our website).
