A George V silver and tortoiseshell part dressing table set, comprising hand mirror, hairbrush and clothes brush, each piqué inlaid with flowers and scroll cartouche, London 1916 by Charles & Richard Comyns, together with a silver oval jewellery box, Birmingham 1919, length 8.6cm, an embossed silver box and cover, Birmingham 1901, length 6.5cm, an embossed silver cylindrical scent bottle case and cover, Chester 1906, and an embossed silver mounted nail buffer.

Condition Report

466. Three-piece set - mirror and hairbrush in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Would benefit from a clean. Typical wear and scratches. The clothes brush has a chipped missing section and crack to tortoiseshell at one end, otherwise typical wear.

Oval box - generally good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear.

Cylindrical perfume bottle case - worn and dents. Missing one bottle to interior.

Purse shaped box - worn with two holes to high points on lid, few dents to body.

Nail buffer - worn with holes to high points on handle.
