A large Zsolnay Pécs porcelain two-handled vase and cover, circa 1870s, of pilgrim flask form, decorated with flowers against a yellow ground, printed and impressed marks to base, height 48cm.

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

There are typical visible long craze lines to the glaze overall. The gilding is very worn and predominantly lacking as it looks as though the flowers and leaves would have been outlined in gilt overall. There are a couple of very minor glaze frits to two of the feet - only noticeable on very close inspection when the vase is inverted.
