LOT 1453

A large Meissen porcelain circular tureen, cover and stand, 19th century, painted with floral bouquets against a wrythen moulded ground within basketweave moulded gilt rims, the cover finial formed as a seated boy and girl holding trailing fruiting vines, crossed swords in underglaze blue to bases, diameter of stand 38cm (minor faults to stand).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

Tureen - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Some typical very light and minor surface scratches.

Cover - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Stand - 2.5cm long by 1cm deep shallow chip to upper rim edge - see image 5 on our website. The central decoration is scratched and there is stacking wear to the raised moulding of the cavetto area of the stand, this area and the rim also has some long craze/hairlines to the glaze, to the underside and upper surface - mostly only visible to one side or the other. The stand 'rings' nicely when tapped.
