A pair of Jacob Petit porcelain candelabra figures, mid-19th century, modelled as a boy and girl flanked by gilt enriched cornucopia raised sconces, raised on foliate painted mound bases, underglaze blue factory marks, height 20cm (restored).

### Condition Report

Girl - in good condition overall, no restoration. A few small and insignificant chips to gilt sconces, some of which have been painted over with gold. A couple of manufacturers firing cracks - to left ankle and beneath pot on trunk.

Boy - figure broken in two through upper torso and visibly but professionally restored, right hand cornucopia stem broken at middle and similarly restored. Some small chips to gilded sconces, some of which painted over in gilt. Fine hairline running horizontally across front of thighs.
