A pair of Copeland Parian busts with column bases, post-1859, modelled as Lesbia and Oenone, after W.C. Marshall, with surface tinting and gilt details, impressed marks, height 41cm (Oenone with minor chip to headdress).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

Oenone - insignificant and inconsequential nicks to petals of two flowers in hair, chip to leafy tip of headdress on top centre of head, number of small chips to circumference edge of top of socle base, minor nick to underside edge of gilt lined upper rim of column base and tiny chip to one corner of column's square base. These are all small damages which are only really noticeable on very close inspection.

Lesbia - the gilt detail has some wear, there are a number of small chips to circumference edge of the top of the socle base, and a minor chip to one base corner of the column base; again all quite inconsequential issues.
