Condition Report

The bowl 'rings' nicely when tapped.

There are no cracks, chips or restoration.

The gilding and enamels are still strong with no real wear although there are a number of significant white patches amidst the decoration - a manufacturing issue - e.g., to the base interior of the bowl and to some of the exterior panels. Some typical very light surface scratches but nothing untoward.
