A group of three 19th century pouch purses, one fitted with two enamelled gilt metal rings and flowerhead terminals, another with cut steel decoration, together with a pair of late 18th century steel shoe buckles, two other purses and two pairs of black silk gloves.

The cream purse is in very nice condition but has two very small splits amongst the folds of the silk, but otherwise seems fine.

The striped purse has a few very small chips to the enamelling on both rings and also to the gilt metal flowerhead terminal, otherwise in generally good order

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
