### LOT 2628

A Victorian Gothic Revival gilt brass table oil lamp, the cut glass reservoir above a cluster column, detailed 'Barclay & Son, Regent Street', the octagonal base raised on winged beast supports, height 71cm (stem drilled and small nicks to reservoir), together with a pair of late Victorian cast brass and pottery wall lights, height 24cm.

### Condition Report

2628. At some stage the lamp had been converted to electricity, but now has a burner mechanism back in place. The electric wire was drilled through at the top of the brass stem and trailed through to the underside of the lamp. The burner is damaged and the retaining lug on the reservoir neck is missing. Otherwise the glass reservoir has a few tiny nicks to the edges and has been glued to the top of the brass stem. The base is missing one of the disc feet.

The two pottery wall lights have overall surface crazing and some slight discolouration.
