A Doulton Lambeth silver plate mounted mustard pot, circa 1883, decorated by A.E. French, monogrammed, of bulbous shape, impressed and incised marks to base, height 6cm, together with a Royal Worcester gilt lined cabinet coffee cup and saucer, painted with fruit, signed, diameter of saucer 11.2cm.

Condition Report

1447. Mustard pot - in generally good condition, silver plate tarnished, very minor surface wear, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Worcester cup - a couple of the tiniest nicks to the rim and footrim, very minor wear to gilt on rim near handle, otherwise in good condition.

Worcester saucer - in generally good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Some surface wear to centre of saucer.

Please note that the Worcester cup and saucer are matched, each piece painted by a different artist.
