A pair of Dresden porcelain two-handled vases and covers, first half 20th century, painted with floral bands within green foliate and gilt line detail, height 19cm, together with a floral painted shell shaped dish, length 29.5cm, a French porcelain scent bottle and stopper and a Continental spill holder, surmounted by a ram (minor faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1421. Dresden vases - both have had their lid glued to the body. One has a repaired handle at the top. Otherwise ok.

Perfume bottle/stopper - the stopper has a crack on the outer edge where it has been knocked in the past. Bottle with small chip to base, some losses/rubbing to gilt decoration.

Dish - small hairline crack to rim beside repaired chip, approx 1.5cm in length, two other large flat chips to underside of rim, otherwise with minor rim fritting.

Spill vase - in generally good condition with minor enamel/gilt losses.
