A Copeland & Garrett Late Spode Felspar Porcelain part service, 1833-1847, painted with Imari pattern 3955, comprising soup tureen, cover and stand, another cover, sauce tureen, cover and stand, three graduated platters, eleven dinner plates, eight soup plates, eleven dessert bowls and seven side plates (some faults).

Estimate: £200 - £400

Condition Report

Overall the service is in very good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. The gilding and decoration is in incredibly good condition with only very minimal wear, with only really the largest platter displaying surface scratches/knife cuts.

The soup tureen body is badly cracked.

The sauce tureen cover has a haircrack running the length of it from the spoon notch.

One of the tea plates has a triangular shaped chip and associated short haircrack to the rim.

Two of the dinner plates are badly cracked, one has a fine hairline approx 9cm long.
