An early Victorian needlework sampler by Amelia Karsey, Aged 8, dated February 1848, finely worked with pious verse above a country manor house, surrounded by deer, plants and insects, within a strawberry border, 41cm x 34cm, within a period pollard oak frame.

Condition Report

2811. An overall browning of canvas and loss of colour to threads. A few small scattered holes, one just above 'Aged' and a few around border and lower right. There is some loss of thread around left side of plants and insects.

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
