A large mixed group of Royal Worcester Evesham Vale pattern tablewares, comprising thirteen soup plates, fifteen dinner plates, eleven salad plates, fourteen tea plates, twelve dessert bowls, two circular tureens and covers, two serving dishes, two sauceboats and three stands, storage jar and cover, jug, sugar bowl and cover, ten teacups and twelve saucers (minor faults).

Estimate: £60 - £80

Condition Report

The dinner plates in particular display usage/dishwasher wear, one has a small chip to the rim edge.

The soup plates are all factory seconds, 2 have minor faults to the rim.

Each of the larger serving pieces have obviously been used as they display wear, the majority are also seconds, e.g., the large oval dish, the tureens and covers.

One sauce boat stand is a seconds with a chip.

The salad plates display wear but to a lesser extent than the dinner plates.

One tea plate has a chipped rim.

One dessert bowl has a chipped rim.

One teacup has a chipped rim.

The remaining items are in good overall condition, with only typical light usage wear.
