A group of Doulton salt glazed stoneware, late 19th and early 20th century, each sprigged with topping scenes, comprising teapot and stand, total height 16.5cm, tobacco jar and cover, two silver mounted jugs and another jug, together with a pair of Dresden porcelain vases, decorated with flowers within green scale borders.

### Condition Report

Teapot cover - broken into at least 3 pieces but professionally restored (very well done), otherwise pot in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Stand has minute nick to upper rim edge, otherwise ok.

Tobacco jar - section of rim and whole cover both professionally restored.

2 silver mounted jugs - both in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Other jug - missing tappet lid, otherwise ok.

Pair of vases - typical rubbing to gilding, otherwise both in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
