A pair of late Victorian silver mounted clear glass spirit flasks and stoppers, each cylindrical body engraved with either 'Whisky' or 'Brandy' beneath a loop handle and silver collar with spout, Birmingham 1900 by Synyer & Beddoes, height 26.5cm (minor faults).

Condition Report

368. Both in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Neither flask is cracked or clouded, but one has a tiny chip beneath the top section of the handle.

The silver mounts have minor misshaping to spouts. Good clear hallmarks. One stopper has numerous chips around edge of terminal. Other stopper does not fit perfectly but is in good order.

Both faceted tops in good condition with only tiny chips to edges.
