A Sitzendorf porcelain Chelsea style scent bottle and stopper, circa 1900, modelled as three figures retrieving fruit from a tree, accompanied by a dog, the stopper surmounted by two birds, underglaze blue mark to base, height 10cm, together with a mixed group of enamel and porcelain scent bottles, miniatures and snuff boxes (minor faults).

### Condition Report

Sitzendorf bottle and stopper - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There are some typical minor chips to the applied leaves, nothing terrible, the brim of the girl's hat has a minor manufacturer's firing crack.

Coalport iron red miniature cup - has a haircrack.

Cobalt blue heart shaped trinket - base extensively broken and visibly glued.

Cylindrical Imari white metal mounted scent - metal lid with small hole and dents.

Two other cobalt blue trinket boxes - both in good condition but with unstuck mount rims.

Otherwise the items in the lot are in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
